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Conditions of Permit

1. In order to operate a golf cart on City Streets, operators shall have a valid driver's license or learner's permit along with a current City issued Golf Cart Permit and proof of insurance. Every motorized golf cart operator must have proof of insurance in possession while operating the motorized golf cart on designated streets and shall produce such proof of insurance on demand of a police officer as specified in Minnesota Statutes Section 169.791.
2. Motorized golf carts may only be operated on designated roadways from sunrise to sunset. They shall not be operated in inclement weather or when visibility is impaired by weather and where unsafe road conditions exist, or at any time when there is insufficient light to clearly see persons and vehicles on the roadway at a distance of 500 feet.
3. The Permit will be issued for a period of one (1) year and there shall be a fee required for administrative services as established in the City of Gem Lake Fee Schedule, and this permit may be renewed annually. The Permit may be revoked at any time if there is evidence that the permittee cannot safely operate the motorized golf cart, after notice and hearing by the City Council.
4. Motorized golf carts shall display the slow moving vehicle emblem provided in Minnesota Statutes Section 169.522, when operated on designated roadways; and be equipped with a rearview mirror capable of viewing at least 200 feet behind the cart.
5. No person shall operate a motorized golf cart on a public sidewalk or trail unless otherwise authorized by the City.
6. All operator permits shall be issued for a specific motorized golf cart. A current City-issued operator's permit tag/sticker shall be plainly visible from the front and/or sides of the motorized golf cart as determined the City of Gem Lake.
7. The motorized golf cart shall be in good working condition and safe for the transportation of passengers.
